They have three facilities in San Angelo. This address is for administration, prevention programs, a resource library (open to the public) and adult outpatient treatment. There is also a house for residential treatment for adult males and a house for residential treatment for women, including those who are pregnant or have up to 2 children with them that are not over the age of six. If placement is through Texas Department of State Health Services (TX DSHS) funding, clients must meet certain criteria and income eligibility guidelines. Some persons with limited income may qualify for sliding scale fee for services.
