

The chart below illustrates the number of active, positive-test confirmations of COVID-19 among those incarcerated in the jail. As testing efforts have dramatically increased, so have the numbers of active COVID-19 cases.








As reported by the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District, there have been **403 incarcerated individuals** and **59 jail staff who have tested positive for COVID-19** from the beginning of the outbreak to June 3, 2020. Out of the total number of cases, **79% of incarcerated individuals and 24% of staff members showed no symptoms**.


As reported by the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District, there have been **411** incarcerated individuals and **60** jail staff who have tested positive for COVID-19 from the beginning of the outbreak to June 10, 2020. Out of the total number of cases, **79% of incarcerated individuals and 23% of staff members showed no symptoms**.














































